Illinois is the fifth state in the U.S. to legislate for L<sup>3</sup>Cs, and Greenline Wheels is one of the first in Illinois to be approved for the distinction. This L<sup>3</sup>C business structure bridges the gap between for-profit and not-for-profit entities, requiring the business to at all times significantly further the accomplishment of one or more charitable or educational purposes. Greenline Wheels, by design, is a low-profit business that seeks to serve a social mission while concurrently achieving economic sustainability. Any profits will be reallocated into the community to support related efforts.
